

FSSL Player Suspension Notification and Card Return Process

If a player receives a double yellow, third yellow or red card at a game the pass will be retained by the referee and sent to the league office.

Player cards are normally received in the league office by the Friday after the game.

When the card is received in the league office the team manager will be notified by email of the player's suspension.

Manager's responsibility

If the team manager DOES NOT receive an email it means the league office has not received the player's card and very likely does not know the player's card was held. It is the manager's responsibility to contact the league office to check on a player's suspension if no email is received.

Player passes are returned to team managers the Monday after the suspension is completed.

An email is sent to the team manager the day the pass goes into the mail.

Manager's responsibility

If the team manager DOES NOT receive an email saying the pass is in the mail he must contact the league office by Wednesday at 9:00am to ensure you will receive the pass back in time for the Sunday game.
