

Registering Youth Players

Players who wish to retain their youth status

Players between the ages of 16-19 may play on adult amateur teams while maintaining their youth status. Youth players must register with their youth league first and then with the adult league. Youth players who do not follow this process will lose their youth eligibility for a period of 12 months.

To register a youth player:

- 1) Request the “Youth Playing in Senior Games” form from the player’s youth club (form is not available through FSSL office)
- 2) Complete form and obtain all signatures (player, coach, parent, FYSA official).
- 3) Have player AND parent sign FSSL liability waiver (use a separate waiver for each youth player)
- 4) Enter player’s data and digital photo into FSSL Online Registration System.
- 5) Submit signed youth registration form to FSSL Office.
- 6) Submit FSSL liability waiver signed by player and parent and notarized to FSSL Office.
- 7) All documents must be received in the FSSL office before a player pass can be issued.

Youth players who are giving up their youth status

Players between the ages of 16-18 may register and play on adult amateur teams using the regular player registration process. Using this process they will **LOSE** their youth eligibility for 12 months.

- 1) Any player under the age of 18 must submit a notarized liability waiver signed by both the player and a parent.
- 2) Enter player’s data and digital photo into FSSL Online Registration System
- 3) Submit FSSL liability waiver signed by player and parent and notarized to FSSL Office.
- 4) All documents and payment must be received in the FSSL office before a player pass can be issued.
